tribute to the great actor Reginaldo Faria, who will be present at the Festival to receive the Crystal Lens-Lifetime Achievement Award during the awards ceremony. His latest film, "The Closer to the Sun, the Brighter" directed by Régis Faria, will be screened on the occasion. To complete the tribute, several of his classic works will be available (free in Brazil and the U.S.) on inff.online platform, highlighting his contribution to the history of Brazilian cinema.

His story takes unexpected turns through his troubled relationship with his mentor, the Cuban Dino Carrera, who nurtures Thiago's talent until he reaches stardom, becoming the principal dancer of the Royal Ballet in London.
