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

The 18th Inffinito Brazilian Film Festival – New York, in partnership with SummerStage Central Park, City Parks Foundation, and New York City Parks, with sponsorship from the Garcia Family Foundation and Embratur, and support from the Consulate General of Brazil in New York, presents a tasting of Brazilian culture through the very best of Brazilian music and cinema.


We begin with IZA, one of the most powerful and celebrated artists in Brazil today — a singer, songwriter, and cultural icon who blends pop, R&B, reggae, and Afro-Brazilian rhythms with a vibrant and authentic soul. With over 3 billion streams on digital platforms, she has been nominated for four Latin GRAMMY Awards and was recognized by MIPAD (Most Influential People of African Descent) as one of the most influential Black artists in the world. Her song "Fé" was covered by Brazilian music legends Caetano Veloso and Maria Bethânia, further affirming her role as a vital voice in contemporary music.

Also performing is the legendary Ilê Aiyê, the first Afro bloc in Brazil, founded in 1975 by Vovô do Ilê and a collective of visionary artists and activists in Salvador, Bahia. Ilê Aiyê is much more than a band — it's a movement. For nearly 50 years, the

group has used music, dance, and Carnival to celebrate African heritage and empower Black communities throughout Brazil, challenging a media landscape that often fails to represent the Black majority of the population. Evandro Fióti is a singer, songwriter, and one of the most exciting creative minds in Brazil today. With deep roots in hip-hop culture and a strong sense of Black identity, Fióti is co-founder of Laboratório Fantasma, where he combines music and activism to promote diversity, inclusion, and cultural appreciation.

To celebrate Brazilian cinema, the program includes the feature documentary Brasiliana: The Black Musical that presented Brazil to the World, directed by Joel Zito Araújo, which will be screened at Thomas Jefferson Park. In addition, two awardwinning short films will be shown—praised for their quality and creativity, and representing the new face of Brazilian audiovisual production: "A girl, a river" by Renata Martins and "Neon Phantom" by Leonardo Martinelli.







Curators



Showrunner, curator, filmmaker, screenwriter, and producer. Her recent works include the reality shows Na Barraca em Busca do Amor (2025), Alta Estima (Seasons 2 & 3 – 2024), and Alta Estima (Season 1 – 2023). Her documentary feature films include Sociedade do Medo (2022), Quero Botar Meu Bloco na Rua (2019), Quanto Tempo o Tempo Tem (2018), Fumando Espero (2015), and Mulheres da Maré (2014). She also created documentary series such as Sons Brasilis (2019), Opção América (2017), Opção Laje (2016), Transgente (2016), among others. In 2020, she founded the streaming platform www.inff.online, where she curates and produces showcases and festivals featuring Brazilian content for both national and international audiences.

She served on the Oscar Committee in Brazil in 2019, was a juror for the Netflix Awards, the Goya Awards Committee in Brazil in 2018, and a juror at the Rio International Film Festival and Cuiabá Film Festival.

She is also the Director of the Festival Forum.



LAURA FERNANDES holds two master's degrees in psychology and has worked as a producer for several music bands featuring Brazilian artists. She interned at TV Globo's Globotec.Later she founded and directed Doc-Vídeo Produções for over ten years. She is currently the director and founder of Minas Production, a Miami-based audiovisual content production company. In addition, she serves as the director of FlaMiami, Flamengo's official embassy in Miami.



RICARDO COTA has been working in film criticism for over 30 years, contributing to newspapers, radio stations, and television networks. A member of the International Federation of Film Critics (FIPRESCI), he has served as a jury member and correspondent at festivals in Brazil and abroad, including in Cuba, Miami, Mexico, Cannes, and Berlin. From 2015 to 2020, he held the position of Curator at the Cinematheque of the Museum of Modern Art (MAM) in Rio, where he played a key role in revitalizing the space with a program focused primarily on Brazilian cinema, while also standing out for international events, such as organizing the 2018 visit to Brazil of cinematographer Vittorio Storaro, a three-time Academy Award winner. He was the curator of the 53rd and 54th editions of the Brasília Festival of Brazilian Cinema. He is currently a curator for Festival do Rio and the Inffinito Film Festival, held in Miami and New York. He is the author of the fiction book Até o Último Filme and the biography A Mulher que Enfrentou o Brasil - A Arte e a Coragem de Niomar Moniz Sodré Bittencourt.



LILIANA KAWASE was born in Bahia, raised in Rio de Janeiro, and now lives in Portugal. An engineer by training and a cinephile at heart, she is a partner and executive producer at Titanio Films, a production and distribution company focused on films, documentaries, and series. In addition to her work in film production, she has also been active as a curator and jury member at film festivals around the world.



Vivíane Spinelli was born in Cuiabá, Brazil. She graduated from Santa Úrsula University in Rio de Janeiro with a degree in Urbanism and Architecture in 1992.

In 1994 she moved to the US, as co-founder and executive director of Inffinito Foundation, in charge of fundraising, management and production of the company's events – having as its main project the Brazilian Film Festival and the worldwide film exhibition platform, www.inff.online.

She directed and produced the short Pioneers and the musical documentary Orchestra on the Road. She was the assistant director of the documentary Smoking I Wait, executive producer of the documentary Transtime and the US producer of the TV Series Option America and feature documentary Society of Fear. In 2018 she received the Brazilian Government and Ministry of External Relations highest honor, the Order of Rio Branco. In October 2023 she was part of the feature film jury for the 21st edition of Cinemato - Film and Video Festival of Cuiaba, MT.
